NOTICE ABOUT THE WRITTEN EXAM

- 1) **Read** carefully the text **before** starting to write
- 2) **Separate** the two **problems** writing them on separate sheets of paper (NOT different pages, different sheets!)
- 3) On **every sheet: SURNAME, NAME** and Polimi identification number
- 4) On **every** face: **page number**
- 5) write well-ordered and clearly readable
Default: **not** well readable = **NOT written**.
- 6) **EXPLAIN EVERYTHING IN DETAIL.**
Default: result reported **without** explanation = **NO** answer.
Questions on the basics of this course require demonstration of used formulas.
- 7) Have special attention where a **quantitative** result is requested
Default: quantitative statement **not given** = **response NOT given**.
- 8) Mobile phones, smart watches, tablets or laptops **are not allowed** at the exam.
- 9) This is a **closed book** exam (any book or note is not allowed)
- 10) If you deem that the written text that you have delivered is sufficient or almost sufficient for the exam, communicate that you want it be evaluated.
Default: **NO communication** = **evaluation NOT wanted**.
